Nursery clothes

Very important

Please could we ask that only the nursery staff allow any body to enter the nursery, even if you know they may be a parent. This is to ensure only the correct authorised collectors of the children are entering the nursery. We feel that it is very important for the children's safety and hope that all parents will be very vigilant and adhere to this. If you here the doorbell as you are leaving please inform a staff member who will then come to the door or if you open the door and a person wants to get into the nursery please **DO NOT** let them in. Close the door behind you and tell them to ring the bell. Thank you for your co-operation in keeping our children safe.

Breakfast club

If your child is not booked in for breakfast club then could you please bring them in at 8am when the session starts.

Nursery hours

We would like to remind all parents of the nursery session times:

Breakfast club – 7:30am – at an extra charge and a place has to be booked.

Morning session – 8am – 1pm

Afternoon session – 1pm – 6pm

All day – 8am – 6pm



We have recently had children being dropped off early and picked up late. If this does happen then parents will be charged £1 for every minute their child is dropped off early or picked up late. This includes 1pm pickups.
