Dates for your diary

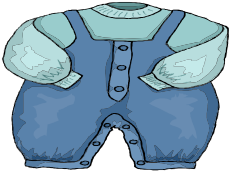
Chinese takeaway day - Monday 6th October, All children will be involved in this event, the local Chinese takeaway will be delivering food to the nursery and serving the children with the food.
