Staff changes

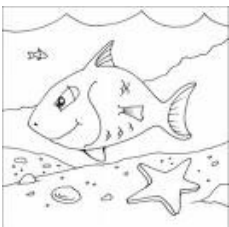
Jamie Shrigley will be leaving Wise Owl on Friday 5th March 2010 we wish her all the best for the future.
