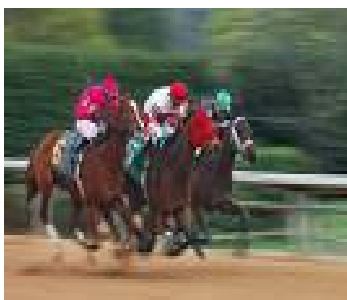
Firstly we would like to say a big hello to our new starter at Wise Owl:-

A big welcome to our two new member's of staff Kerrie Hartley-Sinclair and Zoe Dixon who will be working with the owls and taking over Alice's key person group.

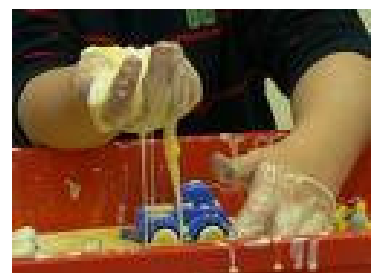


Charity race night
