December 2009

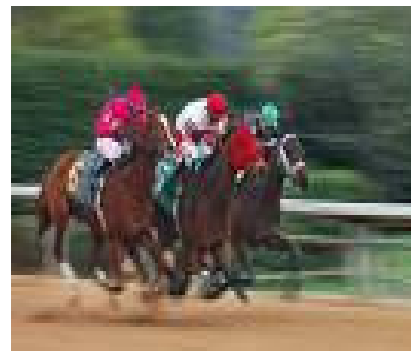
