Childcare fees

Thank you to all our customers who pay their childcare fees on time each month as it makes sure that our nursery workers are also paid on time too. However if fees are not paid by the 5th you will occur a late payment fee to £25. This will be added on your monthly invoice.



We have decided to have a 'No toys policy'. This policy is that no toys from children are to be brought and left at nursery, including watches, cars, bikes, teddies etc.... This is due to previous occasions, as children either loose their toy, it is broken or other children want to play with it. To save these problems from happening in the future this policy has been put into place as from Monday 9th August 2010. If a child has a comforter this will be placed in their bag and only used at sleep times.

East Park

Owlets- Monday 27th September

All children that attend nursery on a Monday are invited to East Park in Hull. But don't worry if your child does not attend this session they are welcome to join us as long as accompanied by an adult. The children will be able to interact with animals such as lamas, Deer and sheep. They will also have the opportunity to explore different natural textures and materials such as bark. We ask that all children are at nursery for 9 o'clock.



Twigmoor Woods



Owls- Tuesday 21st September

All children that attend nursery on a Tuesday morning are invited to Twigmoor woods. But don't worry if your child does not attend this session they are welcome to join us as long as accompanied by an adult. We would like to ask that if your child has wellington boots please could they bring them along as we may get very muddy. The children will explore the woods searching for bugs and insects collecting them for a closer look. They will also have the opportunity to collect natural materials to bring back to nursery to use in different activities. We ask that all children are at nursery for 8:30.

Can we ask that all children are provided with a bag and one set of spare clothes as we don't have many nursery spare clothes and struggle to provide your children with them when they may have an accident. Even if your child is fully toilet trained can you still provide spare clothes as from time to time may get messy or wet during water play.

As the weather is becoming a bit colder can you provide wellies and a coat please, this makes it easier when playing outdoors in the rain. Thank you.
